

Help with the cost of Standard Eye Tests



If the answer is **YES** to any of the following questions you are entitled to an NHS **Standard** Eye Examination free of charge*:

Are you under the age of 16?

Are you 16, 17 or 18 and in full time education?

Are you aged 60 or over?

Registered as blind/partially sighted?

Considered to be at risk of glaucoma by an ophthalmologist?

Aged 40 or over and the parent/brother/sister/child of a person who has or had glaucoma?

Have been prescribed complex lenses under the NHS optical voucher scheme?

Or, if you (or your partner) are receiving one or more of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Pension Credit Guarantee Credit
- Have an NHS Tax Exemption Certificate

*Please note that the NHS does NOT currently cover the cost of the Optomap Retinal Examination.
